## It's Not about Your Performance

**Romans 4:23–24** - ...Now this wonderful statement—that he was accepted and approved through his faith—wasn't just for Abraham's benefit. It was for us, too, assuring us that God will accept us in the same way He accepted Abraham...

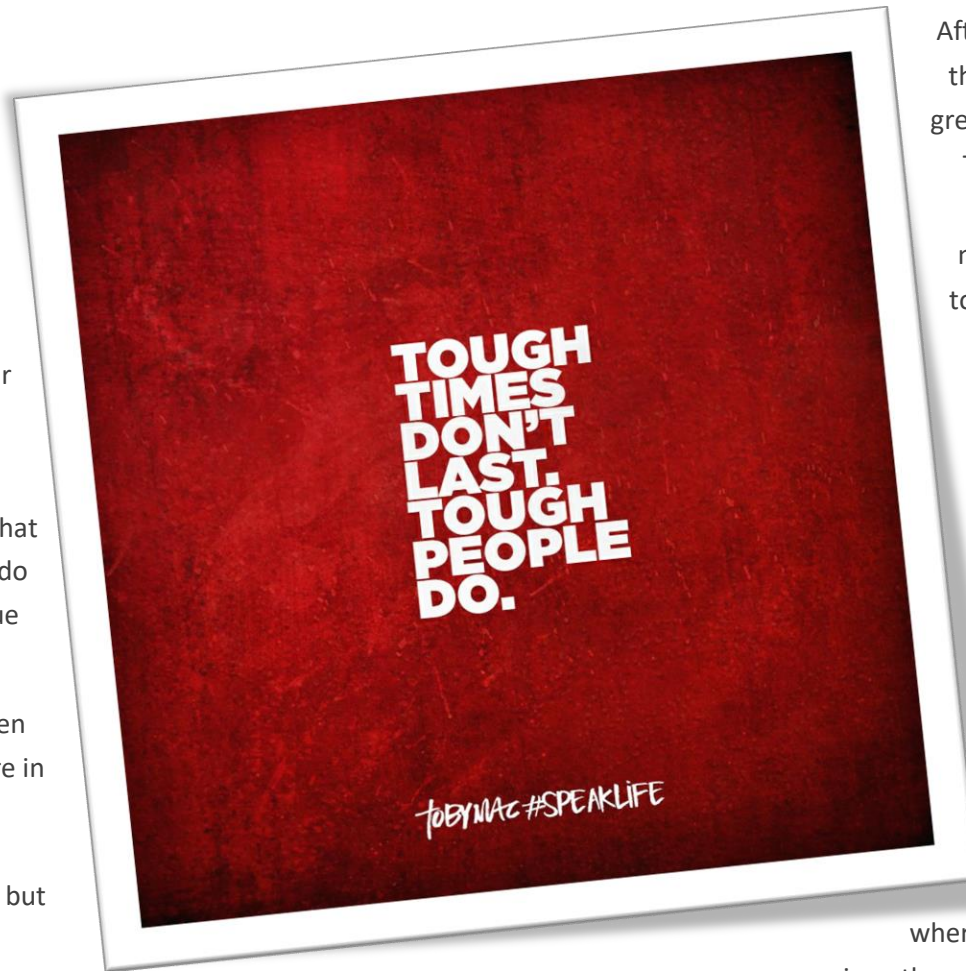
Too often we get our performance mixed up with our identity. You ask somebody, "Who are you?" and they answer, "I'm a nurse" "I'm a supervisor" "I'm in sales"

But the truth is, that's what they do, not who they are. You are a child of the Most-High God. That's where your value, your worth comes from—your who, not what you do.

You may do some wrong things, but that is not who you are. Nothing that you do changes your value because your value comes from your Creator.

So, feel good about who you are. When you're positive toward yourself, you're in agreement with God. If you make a mistake, the moment you ask God to forgive you, He not only forgives you, but He forgets it.

Quit remembering what God has forgotten. Quit listening to all the accusing voices telling you what you're not. Your performance isn't perfect, but you are accepted and approved through your faith. Faith is what matters to God...



## Second Chances

**Jonah 3:1–2** - Then the word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time: "Go to the great city of Nineveh and proclaim to it the message I give you"

After Jonah's first refusal to go and preach to the city of Nineveh, God in His mercy used a great fish to rescue Jonah from certain death.

The story could have ended there, but God doesn't want to just rescue you from your mess, He wants to give you another chance to get to where you're supposed to be. That mistake doesn't disqualify you.

If you repent, turn around, correct your course - God will give you another chance to fulfill His best plan for your life.

The second time God told Jonah to go to the city of Nineveh, he obeyed and saw God do amazing things.

The point is, Jonah's mistake did not stop his destiny. It's not too late to become everything you were created to be. If you'll start right where you are - honoring God, being your best, serving others, the right doors will open, the right people will show up.

When we repent, turn around, correct course – there is 'Good News' – God will cover you with mercy.
