Take The Limits Off

God Doesn't Need a Cloud

Genesis 18:14 - Is anything too hard for the Lord?...

I remember one beautiful, sunny day, we were at the park enjoying the blue sky. All of a sudden, out of nowhere, it began to rain. There wasn't a cloud in the sky. The sun was out – yet there was a rain for a few minutes. We thought, "Where in the world is this rain coming from?"

Nothing is impossible with God. He can make it rain whenever He wants to. He's God. He is All-Powerful. The Creator of the universe. He can use a little cloud, a big cloud, or no cloud. He doesn't need medicine to bring healing. He doesn't need your boss's approval to give you a promotion. He doesn't need a bank account for you to walk in abundance. He is not limited by the natural. But is the God of supernatural.

Whatever you are facing today, no matter what things look like in the natural, know that God has the answer. Trust Him because He can make a way where there seems to be no way. He can make something out of nothing, and He doesn't need a cloud to make it rain!



Ephesians 2:6-7 - He raised us up together with Him...that He might clearly demonstrate through the ages to come the immeasurable (limitless, surpassing) riches of His free grace (His unmerited favor)...

Sometimes we think so small. We limit our possibilities and potential. When God sees you, He sees all your potential. God knows what you're capable of. His grace and favor in your life enables you to become what He sees. But first, you have to open your heart and take the limits off your life.

> How do we limit God? We limit God in our thinking. Thoughts of doubt, unbelief, and unforgiveness in your heart will close the door to His favor. In Mark 6, it says that Jesus could do no great works in a particular town because of the unbelief of the people. It works the same way today.

On the other hand, when you choose thoughts of faith and expectancy, you are opening the door for God to work in your

life. You are taking the limits off. You are giving Him the opportunity to multiply what you have in your hand. Choose to take the limits off by choosing His thoughts of victory. Choose thoughts of increase and blessing. As you do, you'll rise higher and higher and live the abundant life He has prepared for you!
