Habakkuk 3:17–18 - Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crops fails...
YET I will rejoice in the LORD! In the God of my salvation.

The prophet Habakkuk predicted the fall of Judah to the ruthless Babylonians would be a time of devastation and captivity.

In the midst of his discouragement and complaints, he went on to say, "Even when we've lost it all, I will rejoice in the Lord and be joyful in the God of my salvation."
